Art Krinsky served as a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for over 30 years from March 1971 to July 2001. He worked throughout the United States investigating numerous violations including organized crime (traditional and non-traditional), corruption, narcotics, kidnappings, extortion, white-collar crime, bank robberies, and other violations within the FBI's jurisdiction. He also served on the Metro Atlanta Fugitive Task Force.

Mr. Krinsky was designated by the FBI as a Master Police Instructor and he trained FBI Agents, and Agents/Officers of numerous Federal, State, and local agencies. As a certified FBI Undercover Agent, he worked undercover assignments throughout the US, and was a guest lecturer and counselor at the FBI Academy Undercover Sensitive Operations Unit. Thru extensive experience, Mr. Krinsky developed expertise in interviews/interrogation, and informant/source development.

After retiring from the FBI, Mr. Krinsky was appointed Senior Instructor by the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Law Enforcement Training Center and instructed in the Legal, Practical Applications, and Counterterrorism Divisions. He continues as a peer supporter for the Critical Incident Stress Management Division, and as an instructor at law enforcement academies across the US.
