Cole Thaler is an attorney and co-director of the Atlanta Volunteer Lawyers Foundation's Safe & Stable Homes Project. In that role, he trains and recruits volunteer attorneys to represent low-income tenants in their housing cases. Prior to working at AVL, Mr. Thaler worked at Georgia Legal Services Program, representing low-income rural Georgians in a variety of civil matters. Mr. Thaler is also the founder of Paws Between Homes, a nonprofit animal rescue that provides temporary foster homes for the pets of people who are being evicted. Mr. Thaler graduated from Northeastern University School of Law and Williams College.
